Sponsored by Willamette United Soccer Club in West Linn, Oregon, the tournament will be held from August 20-23, 2009 for U9-U14 boys and girls teams of all playing levels.

- Travel teams are scheduled for early games on Sunday, facilitating a reasonable start to the trip back home.
- For U9-U10 teams: No games on Thursday. Two Divisions per age group. Maximum of 16 teams per Division.
- Great sponsor deals, on-site vendors, cool coupons and discounts.
